<b>CONSEQUENCE 4</b> <b>Challenging Behaviour</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Missing an after school detention</li> <li>• Arguing, swearing at, or answering back to any staff</li> <li>• Vandalism or damage to books or a room</li> <li>• Verbal or physical threats to any person.</li> <li>• Physical violence to any person.</li> <li>• 20 or above yellows</li> </ul>	<b>You will be placed in internal isolation.</b> <b>EXCLUDED if appropriate.</b> <b>A letter about your behaviour will be sent to your parents.</b>
